

Antioch Baptist Church presents Outrigger Island VBS

Surf's up, so grab your surfboard and head for the waves! During VBS 2008, kids will know, speak, and live God's truth...aloha style. Based on Psalm 86:11, Outrigger Island is more than a tropical paradise. It's the place where kids will develop the stability they need to face a world of shifting sands and wavering opinions.

Antioch Baptist Church will present "Outrigger Island: Living God's Unshakeable Truth" from June 16 through June 20, beginning at 6:00 p.m. nightly. Vacation Bible School lasts for two-and-a-half hours, and includes a nightly Bible lesson, crafts, snacks, music, and recreation. Each station is visited on a rotation schedule each evening.

Vacation Bible School also teaches us the A.B.C.'s of Becoming a Christian. This is a tool Lifeway has used for several years now, and has proven to be quite effective. The A.B.C.'s are described as:

- A. Admit to God you have sinned
- B. Believe that Jesus is God's Son
- C. Confess your faith in Jesus as Lord

Each evening comes with a "high tide Wave," which brings us a lesson in living God's truth. With each wave comes a nightly theme song, Bible story, and life truth.

For Wave 1 on Monday evening, Outrigger Island takes us back to the story of God speaking to Moses, based on Exodus 3, 13, and 14. We learn that God is real, and that we can believe there is no other God.

Tuesday brings with it Wave 2, when we look at Jesus as God's Son, based on Luke 2, 25, and 41. Luke teaches that we can know that Jesus is God's Son, and we can celebrate who He is.

On Wednesday evening, Wave 3 washes in the story of Jesus' Death, Burial, and Resurrection, based on Mark 15. We learn this evening that Jesus is the only way to Heaven, and that we as Christians should confess Jesus as our Savior.

Wave 4, on Thursday evening, brings with it the story of Jeremiah and Baruch from Jeremiah 36. We learn from Jeremiah that the Bible is the true Word of God, and that we can explore the truth within.

Finally, on Friday evening, Wave 5 brings us the story of the Good Samaritan, based on Luke 10. The story of the Good Samaritan teaches us that our actions should show what we say we believe. We also learn that we can and *should* stand for the truth. The worship rally for Friday evening will include commencement, and will be followed by a Grand Blowout Luau filled with food and fun! Commencement begins at 6:30 p.m. Classes at 6 p.m.
